All bookings must be made online through the My Family Lounge portal or app.

FEES~ Debit Success process all OSHC fees and provide two options below:

Debit Success will provide two payment options:

- 1) Credit card (2.35% surcharge)
- 2) Direct debit from bank account (no cost involved)

Please note that our service will not be able to accept any booking until the Debit Success form is completed. This can be done by updating your enrolment form through the 'My Family Lounge' portal.

All outstanding fees on your **account must be up to date prior to** commencement of Vacation Care. If you experience any difficulty with these requirements, please contact the Coordinator.

Activities Undertaken: We will be viewing G or PG rated movies & children will receive a small bag of lollies, popcorn and bottle of water. There will be 1 adult to 10 children supervision ratio at all times

Destination & Address: Wet n Wild, Pacific Motorway, Oxenford. Wet n Wild is a water theme park with life guards supervising designated swim areas.

Activities Undertaken: We will be swimming and going on the water rides. When swimming, there will be 1 adult to 6 children ratio for children in prep to grade 1 and children identified as not competent and at beginner stage on the swimming ability form. Prep and Yr 1 children will not go in the wave pool.

There will be a 1 adult to 8 children ratio for children in Yr 2 and 1 adult to 10 children ratio for children in Yr 3 to Yr 5 and 1 adult to 12 children ratio for children in Yr 6 who have been identified as intermediate and advanced swimmers.
