**Under this agreement for 2018
Southport State School will receive**

\$345,031*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students school wide achieving a 'C' standard or above in English to 85%
- Increase the percentage of Prep students achieving benchmark reading levels from 80% in 2017 to 85% at or level D-E end of 2018
- Improve and increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN NMS in Reading (Year 5) from 96% to 100%
- Increase the percentage of students performing in the U2B of Reading (Year 5) from 25% to 40%
- Improve and increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN NMS in Reading (Year 3) from 86% to 95%
- Increase the percentage of students performing in the U2B of Reading (Year 3) from 24% to 40%
- Facilitate teacher development by building collective capacity and transforming pedagogy and instructional coaching

Our initiatives include

- Continued implementation of Explicit Instruction program for students in Year Prep-6
- Implementation of a targeted Oral Language program in Prep & Year 1
- Provide additional NCT to enable PLC's of teachers/leaders to engage in collaborative data inquiry, action learning, classroom visits and professional conversations
- Revisit, refine and revise the school Pedagogical Framework and embed it as the shared language of teaching and learning
- Develop and implement a whole school approach to the teaching of Guided Reading

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing a 1.0 Pedagogical Coach to improve all explicit teaching pedagogies in the areas of reading through the formalised PLC process: \$122,408
- Employing .6 Literacy teacher to deliver literacy intervention and support in a whole class model in Prep-4: \$43,399
- Employing 1.0 Director of Teaching & Learning to develop and implement a 'Whole School' intervention framework: \$106,103
- Delivering intervention programs in Literacy and Numeracy for identified students by employing teacher aides for the early years and additional EAL/D teacher/teacher aide support: \$66,121
- Additional resources to support above mentioned programs: \$7,000
