

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

As a result of hygiene awareness, we have introduced an alcohol-based hand sanitiser into our classrooms. The hand sanitiser will be stored in a safe location in classrooms and students will be supervised by a staff member when using.

The current brand is Accept Concepts Hand Sanitiser Gel, however, we can't always be sure that this particular brand will always be available.

To encourage good hygienic habits, it is also important to continue to encourage your children to:

- wash their hands regularly with soap and water, particularly before and after eating, and after going to the toilet;
- use alcohol-based hand sanitiser if soap is unavailable;
- cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue or the inside of their elbow; and
- dispose of tissues in the bin immediately.

Anyone with known allergies to alcohol-based hand sanitiser should not use these products. Parents should check the manufacturer's recommendations before use. If you have any concerns regarding your child's use of hand sanitiser, you should consider seeking medical advice prior to giving consent. Ingredients: Alcohol 70%, acrylic polymer, triethanolamine.
